NON-DISCRIMINATION AND RESPECT FOR MOTHER NATURE

ECOLOGICAL 4-WHEELING ADVENTURES is an equal-opportunity service provider and permittee for all properties traveled. We only use designated trails and areas, and have the utmost respect for Mother Nature.

DISCUSSION: Make college trip reservations through them and understand their policies, too. College class, prior trip participation or an orientation lecture is not required to participate in our EXPLORING TRIPS. Insured, street-legal, 4-wheel-drive vehicles with a low-range transfer case and reasonable ground clearance are required, except as noted in the trip descriptions. Stock sport utility vehicles in good mechanical condition are encouraged, and generally, modifications are not required. All-wheel-drive, sedan, or van-type vehicles and towed trailers, regardless of design, are not accepted unless noted. For all trips, you must have: drinking water, CB radio, spare tire and equipment to change it, working seatbelts, windshield wipers/washers, yank strap, metal top or roll bar, trash bag, toilet paper and shovel. Most-difficult (black diamond) trips may require vehicle modifications. Camping trips require self-contained camping gear plus food and drinks. See the REQUIREMENTS section of each trip description for additional stipulations. You should be prepared to operate on your own.

Every participant, regardless of age, must submit a separate, completed REGISTRATION/LIABILITY form. A completed VEHICLE SELF INSPECTION form for the vehicle and this EXPLORING TRIP POLICY form are also required from the primary registrant. All furnished accommodations and meals are based on double occupancy. Single travelers pay the same rate. Harry Lewellyn and Roger Vargo reserve the right to screen and reject any reservation or participant, while on a trip, for past or trip incompatible behavior.

ITINERARY: Due to the expeditionary nature of all EXPLORING TRIPS, the exact accommodations, meals and itinerary may change. Every effort is made to conduct the trips exactly as presented, but that is not guaranteed. When changes are made that affect trip cost, additional fees may be requested or partial refunds issued for the change in service.

RESERVATION PROCEDURE: Telephone reservations are not accepted. You may reserve with (confirmed) or without (unconfirmed) a deposit. Include your name, address, home and work telephone numbers, email and the name of the trip(s) of interest. A preliminary information packet is immediately mailed to confirmed reservations. Several weeks before the trip, confirmed reservations receive a final trip information packet. Unconfirmed reservations will be notified only if space is available. DEPOSITS, FEES and REFUNDS: Deposits and fees are specified in the trip descriptions. A 20 percent late fee is added to trips booked six weeks or less before the trip. Cancellations are only accepted by mail. A partial deposit or trip fee refund may be made, less a \$20 cancellation fee, for trips canceled by you, in writing, and filled by another. Deposits and trip fees are also transferable to other trips (less the \$20 cancellation fee) within the same year as your original booking date. Otherwise, deposits and trip fees are NON-REFUNDABLE regardless of reason, partial or non-participation. A full refund and apology are made for trips canceled by ECOLOGICAL 4-WHEELING ADVENTURES.
